Atrium's orthopedic surgeons treat acute injuries, chronic instability, overuse syndromes, arthritis, fractures and more in the shoulder, elbow, arm, back, wrist and hand, hip, knee, leg, ankle and foot.

Fractures and other bone and joint injuries are the most common problems treated among trauma patients.



Pre-Surgical Education Program

Atrium offers a Total Joint Replacement Education Program and a Spine Surgery Boot Camp for patients prior to surgery.

Surgical Procedures

Board certified physicians—many of them fellowship trained—perform a wide range of procedures, including:

- Advanced Arthroscopic Surgery – minimally invasive procedure that inspects, diagnoses and repairs problems inside a joint

- Anterior Cruciate Ligament (ACL) Reconstruction – reconstructs the ACL and restores knee stability
- Carpel Tunnel Surgery – diminishes symptoms in hand or wrist when bracing, splinting, pain relievers and corticosteroid injections cannot
- Joint Replacement Surgery – replaces a worn or injured joint with a new artificial joint in the hip, knee, shoulder or ankle. Atrium offers an anterior approach to hip replacement that results in a smaller incision, less recovery time and fewer mobility restrictions for patients.
- Spinal Surgery – helps conditions such as lumbar spine arthritis, osteoporosis, ruptured/herniated disc, spinal stenosis with procedures such as discectomy and laminectomy with or without fusion or fixation.

Rehabilitation

Atrium's CARF Accredited Rehabilitation Center offers personalized, intensive therapies for those who qualify. Sports Medicine and Physical Therapy centers are located in Middletown, Franklin, Lebanon, Mason and Springboro to make continuing recovery for patients convenient and easy as possible.
